
TOP 10 TIPS FOR TEACHING AND UNDERSTANDING

AuDHD

- Provide structured routines with small, predictable variations.
- Recognise delayed processing during overwhelm.
- The student may have intense focus on details whilst missing bigger picture.
- Casual comments can cause devastating emotional reactions.
- They can hyperfocus intensely on interests but struggle to attend to non-preffered tasks.

- ADHD impulsivity interrupts conversations while Autism makes reading social cues difficult.
- Hiding both ADHD hyperactivity
 AND autistic traits creates double
 the mental load and faster
 burnout.
- Sensory needs fluctuate daily.
- The same student may need routine one day and novelty the next
- Break everything into micro-steps.
